2026 PASTURE COMPETITION



RULES OF ENTRY:

1. The competition is open to any person, partnership or company; provided that the pasture exhibited is within a holding owned or managed by that person, partnership or company.
2. The pasture being exhibited must be within the Wingecarribee Shire.
3. Whole paddocks will not be judged, due to the limited time that judges have on each entrant's property. Rather a representative section of paddocks of 1 hectare (100m x 100m) in size should be marked with a marker such as a steel post in each corner with fertilizer bags on them.
4. Entrants are encouraged to have information at hand on paddock histories including relevant information such as grazing history, recent fertilizer/lime application, sprays etc.
5. Entry fee of \$20 must be received by the pasture committee prior on the day of judging (cash or Credit Card).
6. Property owner or manager must be available to meet judge at property entrance on judging day. Judging day and approx. time will be notified 48hrs prior.
7. Judges reserve the right to alter the judging criteria as deemed necessary for the different categories.
8. In the event of cancellation of the event for any reason, the committee's decision will be final.
