# Dairy Cattle Regulations

1. All cattle must be under total control of their attendants.
2. Age to be taken from January 1st 2026.
  - a. Heifer Under 6 months – Born between 1st July 2025 and 1st January 2026.
  - b. Heifer under 12 months - 1st January 2025 and 1st January 2026.
  - c. Heifer 12 – 18 months – 1st July 2024 – 1st January 2025.
  - d. Heifer 18 months - 2 years – 1st January 2024 – 1st July 2024.
  - e. Female in milk under 2 years six months – 1st July 2023 – 1st July 2024.
  - f. Female in milk 2 years six months – 3 years – 1st January 2023 – 1st July 2024.
  - g. Female in milk 3 – 4 years – 1st January 2022 – 1st January 2023.
  - h. Female in milk 4 – 5 years – 1st January 2021 – 1st January 2022.
  - i. Female in milk 5 years and over – Born before 1st January 2021.
3. Prize winners to be on the ground and to parade when called on.
4. All attendants must appear in clean and tidy condition, or in Breed Uniforms, when leading cattle to be judged on parade.
5. Prize winners competing in Pens or Groups not permitted to parade displaying previously won ribbons.
6. Loss by Disease. The signing of the Certificate of Entry of any animal will be taken as a guarantee that the specified animal is free from disease. In cases of infectious diseases being spread through or by an exhibit, the exhibitor shall be responsible.
7. In cases of joint ownership, points for most successful exhibitor only to be awarded to name in which the exhibit has been entered.
8. Premier cattle breeders of each breed to be an exhibitor on the day.
9. Exhibitors, please bring own washing hoses and water troughs.
10. Indemnity Forms MUST be signed by all competitors.
11. Registration Certificates must be produced if required by Stewards and/or Inspectors.
12. All cattle must have NLIS tags.
13. Owners &/or exhibitors/competitors are solely responsible for the care & control of all stock in their charge. They must exercise due caution in regard to public safety. It is their responsibility to ensure that they have adequate public liability & livestock insurance.
14. ALL STALLS TO BE LEFT CLEAN AND TIDY AT COMPLETION OF THE SHOW.
